Couples' Bowling - Ed and Joan Kearney

On Tuesday, June 21st, the Carolina Colours Alley Cats held their Couples' Bowling "Summer Classic" at Strike Zone. Nineteen couples participated in an afternoon of fun and friendship. The event commenced with the ever popular "9 Pin" format. Knock down 9 pins on your first ball and a strike automatically registers on the monitor. Patrick Lally topped all bowlers with a 207, recording strikes in the 7th, 8th, and 9th frames before bowling three real strikes in the 10th frame, (aka a "turkey"). Sonny Aluzzo finished second with 194 and Archie Portis and Herb Martin tied for third place with 168. Ladies high honors went to Helen Jabs with 183. Helen marked in eight of the ten frames, including four strikes. First time bowler Barbara Leister recorded five strikes and placed second with 155, followed by Sandy Berberich in third place with 137.

Game two was Even/Odd. This scoring format was first introduced at the Winter Classic and was a huge success. Strike Zone management programmed the scoring monitors to record a strike each time an even number of pins was knocked down and a spare each time an odd number was struck down. Gutter balls were scored as a spare. The Even/Odd format generated a great deal of enthusiasm and the majority of bowlers exceeded 200!!!! Patti Peebles and first time bowler Lynn Carpenter tied and led all bowlers with 244. Each rolled eight strikes with Patti rolling six in a row. Barbara Leister placed second with 230 and Marilyn Biers, who opened with five strikes in a row, placed third with 222. Sonny Aluzzo topped the men's scoring with 237, followed by Archie Portis with a 231 and Steve Forney with a 227. Claudia Zink tied Dyane Carlson's Winter Classic record of knocking down an odd number of pins in every frame, only to end the game with an even number and strike on her last ball. Dan and Judy Damweber, wearing their college sweetheart bowling shirts, were nominated "Cutest Couple" - see photo.

The evening concluded with Sonny and Carol Aluzzo hosting a light dinner prepared by Chef Katherine. Our next Couples' Bowling event is planned for October. A Save the Date reminder will be sent out in mid August. Due to the large turnout, Strike Zone management has suggested we continue with a Tuesday afternoon time frame. Anyone who would like to participate should contact Ed or Joan Kearney; no prior bowling experience is necessary. Most of our members are once in a blue moon bowlers.
